

Neutralizer Handicapped Leagues

501 / Cricket - match supplement

Format

Neutralizer Handicapped Leagues use the approved 501/Cricket sequence with Neutralizer handicaps. They are offered as separate scoring groups within the existing Vegas and Economy Express offerings, including their available Singles and Doubles divisions. The corresponding league fees, season length, launch size and awards remain in effect.

Individual eligibility and statistics

Every player must provide individual 01 points-per-dart average (PPDA), Cricket marks-per-round (MPR), and the league sources for those statistics. Each Neutralizer Handicapped League player must have a verified 01 PPDA from 10 through 30, inclusive. A player above 30 PPDA is not eligible. Both doubles partners must qualify separately. A team average cannot qualify an out-of-range player. Missing or unverified statistics require administrator review.

Handicap use

Use the applicable approved Neutralizer chart or administrator-configured scoring settings for 501 and Cricket. Record assigned starts or marks on the match sheet. This supplement does not supply a new handicap formula. Preserve individual statistics; a handicapped starting score must not be treated as an unhandicapped 501 start when recording points scored.

Regular-season match order

Play all eleven games. Games 1, 2, 5, 7, 10 and 11 are 501; games 3, 4, 6, 8 and 9 are Cricket. Both doubles partners play every game. Record individual game wins.

Main playoffs

The top four players or teams qualify. Seed 1 plays seed 4; seed 2 plays seed 3. Each semifinal and the final is one match, best of 21 (race to 11). Stop at eleven wins. One round is played per week. Playoff 501 games are 1, 2, 5, 7, 10, 11, 12, 13, 16, 18 and 21; all other listed games are Cricket. There are no playoff fees.

Administration

Keep Neutralizer Handicapped League groups separate from Open groups. Registration does not grant approval, payment credit or a league launch. The established registration, payment invitation, replacement, management-exception and manual ADA-entry procedures continue to apply. Paper sheets do not submit results. Scope

This supplement records the owner-confirmed match format. It does not guarantee ADA Nationals eligibility or Pro status, authorize production activation, or replace the corresponding league rules. ADA determines recognition and event eligibility.
